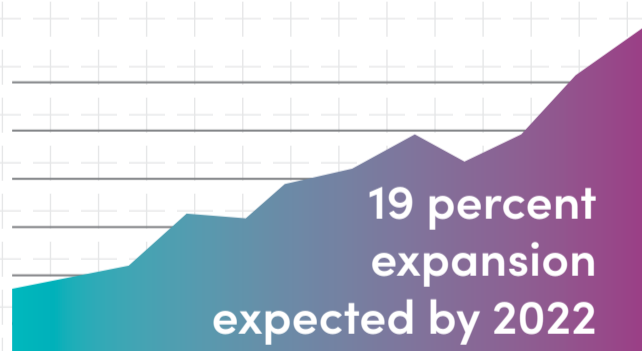
Higher Education for Nursing

There are three higher education paths RNs can take to advance their careers

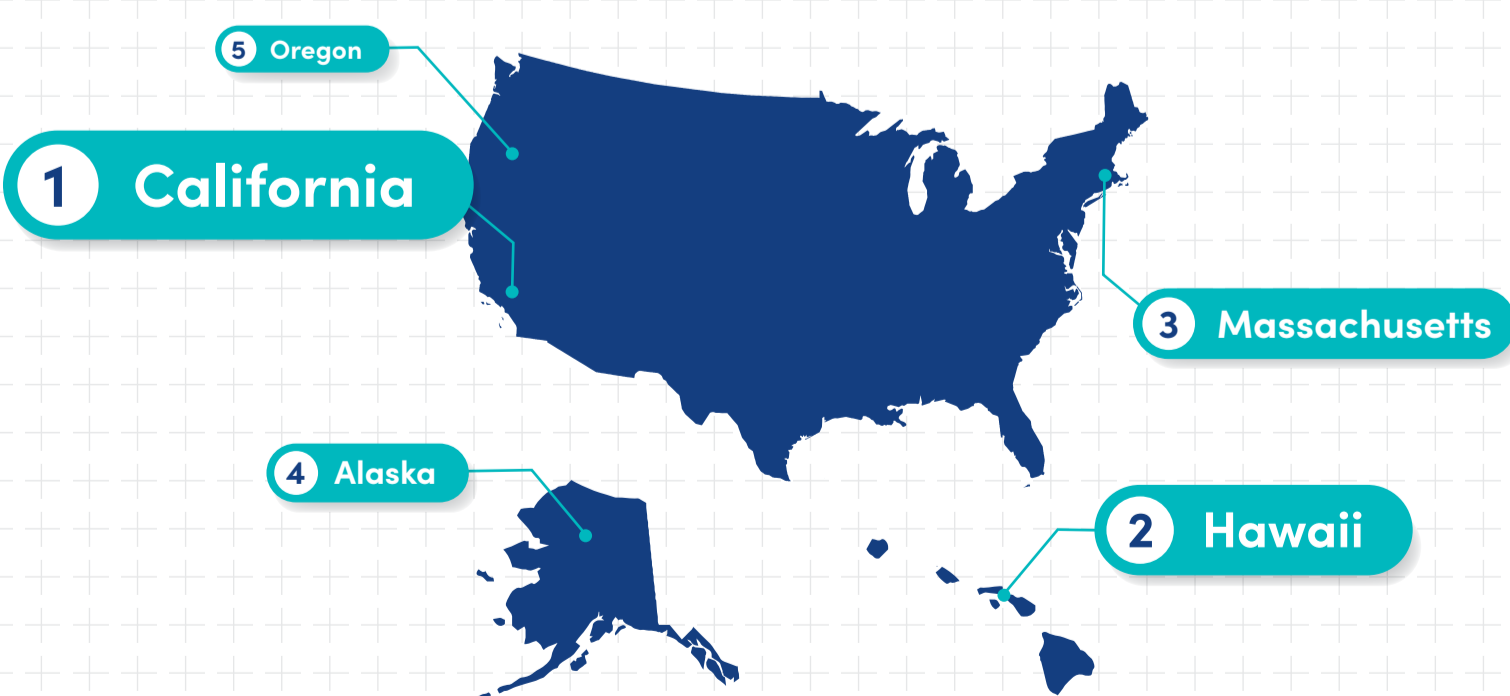


Job Growth for RNs
