



DO YOUR RESEARCH

Learn about the organization, values and beliefs, and work culture.

PRACTICE YOUR ANSWERS

Write your answers and practice them with a colleague to get used to interviews.

DRESS FOR THE OCCASION

Depending on the position, sometimes well-pressed scrubs are more appropriate.

HAVE A QUESTION READY

"What's the typical schedule like for a nurse working here?"

BE YOURSELF

Smile and enjoy your time with the interviewer. Approach things from a positive point of view.



DON'T SOCIAL MEDIA SEARCH

Don't look for your interviewer's socials to focus on common interests.

DON'T WING IT

You'll most likely stall for time when answering and come across as under prepared.

DON'T ROLL STRAIGHT OUT OF BED

Sweats may be acceptable down the line, but definitely not for a first impression.

DON'T JUST LEAVE

Express interest in the hospital you're applying to. Ask about the culture, protocols, etc.

DON'T USE NEGATIVE LANGUAGE

Avoid using words that have negative attributes to maintain a positive image.
